

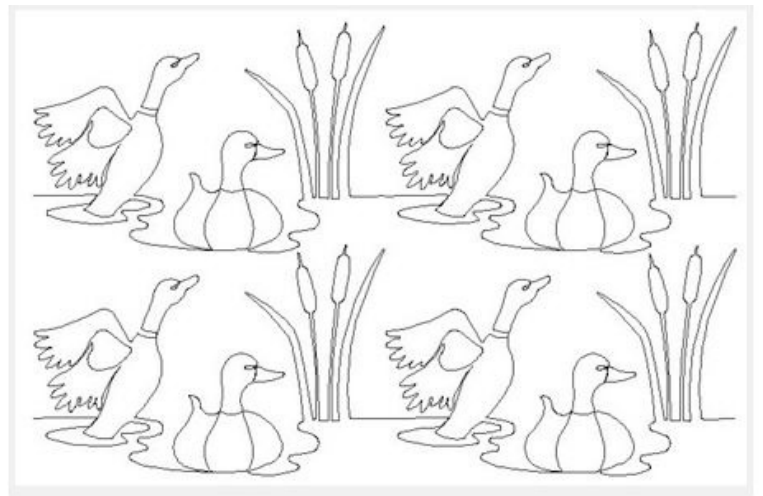
HAIKU
